WHAT IS THE NDT APPROACH?

NDT (Neuro-Developmental Treatment) is a hands-on, problem-solving approach to the examination and treatment of the impairments and functional limitations of individuals with neuropathology, primarily children with Cerebral Palsy and adults with stroke or traumatic brain injury (TBI).

The individual's strengths and impairments are identified and addressed in relation to functional abilities and limitations. The NDT Approach continues to evolve with the emergence of new theories, models, research, and information in the movement sciences. Intervention involves direct handling and guidance to optimize function. The approach is guided by the client's reactions throughout every treatment session.



An NDT Trained or NDT Certified™ therapist's education in neurology, physiology, and current research is translated into daily practice. They work collaboratively with

patients, families, caregivers, and other healthcare professionals to develop individualized comprehensive treatment programs based on NDT theory and philosophy.
